Application Submission Instructions

Your initial application must include the following:

- **PART 1 – Student Athlete Information** - Completed by the athlete/parent.
- **PART 2A – Student Athlete Personal Response** - Completed by the athlete.
- **PART 2B – Academic Intake Form** – Completed by the athlete/parent.
- **Copy of all report cards issued to date for previous and current academic years.**
- **\$250 non-refundable application fee** – see instructions below.

Once your application has been reviewed, NSA will contact athletes/parents to schedule a personal interview.

The following components will be requested after the interview:

- **PART 3 – Confidential School Recommendation** - Completed by the school.
- **A current Credit Counselling Summary OR a transcript** from your child's guidance department (for students currently in grade 9 – 11).
- **PART 4 – Confidential Coach Reference** - Completed by the ski coach.
